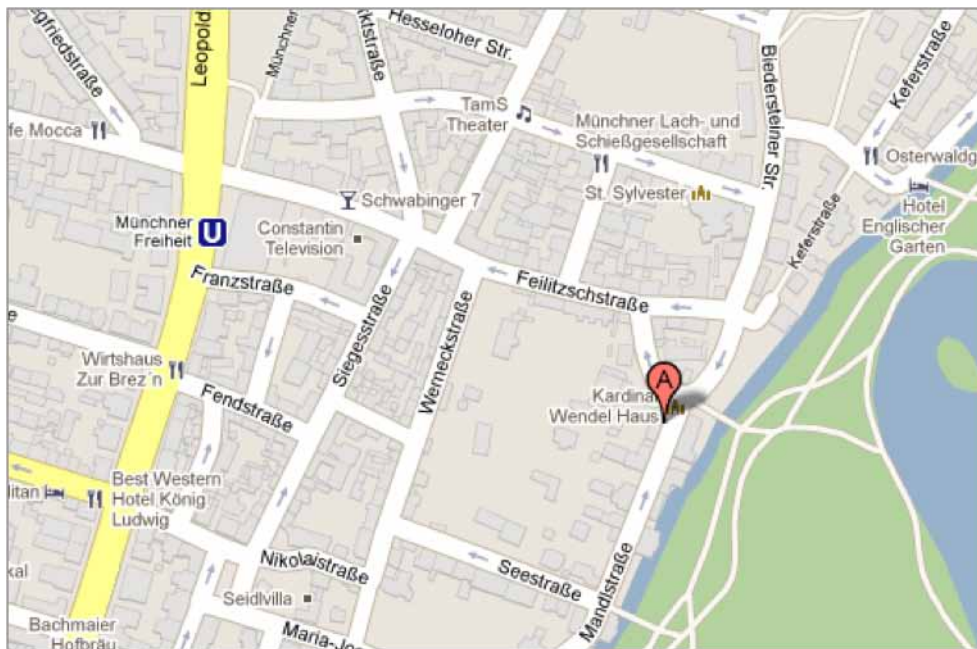

By airplane

 S1 or S8 from the airport to »Marienplatz«.  Change to the underground U3 or U6 to »Münchner Freiheit«. From there 5 minutes to walk through the Feilitzschstraße and the Gunezrainerstraße to Mandlstraße 23. (approx. 60 minutes)

By train

 Take one of the S-train-lines to »Marienplatz« (all lines are possible).  Change to the underground U3 or U6 to »Münchner Freiheit«. From there 5 minutes to walk through the Feilitzschstraße and the Gunezrainerstraße to Mandlstraße 23. (approx. 10-15 minutes)


By taxi

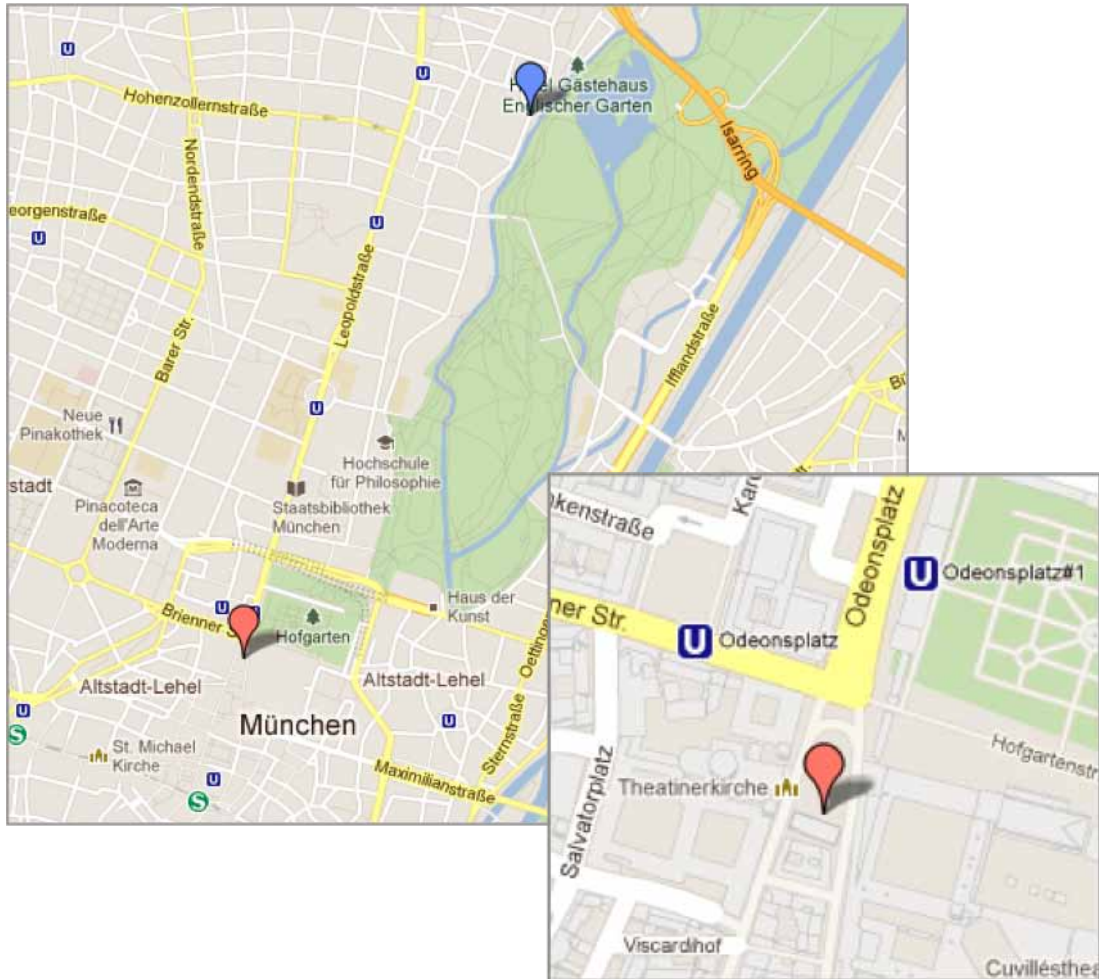

By car
