INFOBOX

Attention! Population change: Do not use wave 8 data for general analyses of the parent population.

In wave 8, the focus of the parent survey changed from "'parenthood"' to "'grandparenthood"'. The goal in doing so was to pique the interest of the respondents. This change led to a reduction in the questionnaire and to a considerable change in the population:

Instead of interviewing all (living) parents who are in contact with the anchor were eligible, the group was further specified to (living) parents who are in contact with the anchor who lives with at least one biological or adopted child in a shared household (see also the anchor questionnaire for wave 8: Consent to the grandparent survey). As the data from the parent survey in wave 8 only represents grandparents, analyses of the parent population should not include wave 8 data.
